For Information

Orkney Islands Council provides assistance with free school meals and clothing allowances (to contribute to the purchase of essential outer clothing/footwear for school use). The clothing allowance for 2019-2020 is £100.00 per eligible child. To be awarded assistance, proof must be provided that you are in receipt of a qualifying benefit. Please see the table below for further details.

^{*} Assistance may be awarded depending on the income stated on your Award letter or Tax Credit Award Notice for 2019-20. If you are receiving Child Tax Credit only (and not Working Tax Credit) your annual household income must be below £16,105; if you are receiving Child Tax Credit and Working Tax Credit, your annual household income must be below £6,900; or if you are in receipt of Universal Credit, your monthly earned income must be below £610.

Submitting an Application

One application is suitable for all the children in your family, even if they are attending different schools within Orkney. If your circumstances change you must notify us immediately. A fresh application must be submitted each academic year.

Nursery

If you are in receipt of one of the qualifying benefits listed above, you should complete an application form to apply for free school meals if your child attends nursery for a full day. However, children in nursery are not entitled to a clothing allowance.

Primary 1-3

All children in P1-3 are automatically entitled to a free school meal without the need to fill out this application form. However, you should still complete the form if you are applying for a clothing allowance.

Primary 4 and up

If you are in receipt of one of the benefits listed, then you should complete an application form to apply for free school meals and clothing allowances.

16-18 Year Olds

If you are applying for assistance for a child who is beyond statutory school leaving age, this will not be awarded until **after the summer break** once we have received confirmation from the school that they have returned for further study. Pupils aged 16-18 and still at school may apply for assistance in their own right if they are in receipt of any of the qualifying benefits.

Deadlines

Applications can be submitted at any point throughout the school year. However, these will not be backdated and will only be paid from the date your application is approved by this office. Please bear in mind that during June-September we receive a large number of applications and it may take up to 4 weeks to process your application. Contact us if you have not received your award letter **after** this time.

Start Dates

Once we have processed your completed application form we will notify the school of your child's entitlement to free school meals. Ideally, you should submit your application before **2 August 2019** to receive free school meals from the start of term, otherwise they will be provided from the date we approve the application.

Payment Methods

Clothing Allowances can either be made by BACS or by cheque. If you would prefer for the allowance to be paid into your bank account, please complete the bank mandate at the end of the application form. It is important that you take care when filling in your details as we cannot be held responsible for missed or delayed payments as a result of errors on your bank mandate.
