The Learning Opportunities this term will include:

### Language

#### Reading

We will read 'The Boy with the Striped Pyjamas' as our class novel this term. Children will be given regular opportunities to read quietly in class every day. They have set an 'accelerated reader' target which they will collect points for until the end of term. We will continue to engage in 'close reading' each week by looking at a short text in detail and answering questions.

#### Writing

Writing this term will focus on journalistic writing, developing characters, setting and plot in imaginative pieces as well as evaluation of writing and redrafting/ editing. We will also write reports and persuade readers by writing about both sides of an argument in discursive pieces of writing.

#### Talking and Listening



### Maths

We will be looking at the following areas:

- **Multiples, factors and primes**
- **Fractions, decimal fractions and percentages**
- **Measurement**
- **Expressions and equations**
- **Four operations: addition, subtraction, division and multiplication**

We will continue to do regular mental mathematics each week in a variety of ways .

### Topic:

Our topic this term is 'World Conflict' and will focus on WW2. The children will learn about the topic through the eyes of a wartime character whom they will become during topic time. The children will be in wartime families in class and will experience the ups and downs of wartime through a 'living history' approach. Children will be involved in dramatising the events and making decisions with consequences for their families.

This project will culminate in a Victory party in class. Children will be involved in organising a war-time bake off in class using authentic recipes.
